

**Saint John XXIII Catholic School Community
School Advisory Committees**

Nomination Committee: (required) The Nominations Committee shall be responsible for recruiting and acquiring nominees for the School Advisory Board. The committee will interview each qualified applicant at a special meeting in April. They will review and discuss their choices, and shall select the nominees and submit to the Pastor of St. Bernadette Catholic Church for his approval and/or appointment.

Executive Committee: (required) The members of the Executive Committee shall be the Pastor, Principal, President, Vice-President and Secretary of the Advisory Board. The Executive Committee will meet regularly to plan the agenda for the regular Advisory Board meetings. The Executive Committee may exercise the powers of the Board while the Board is not in session.

Marketing Committee: The Marketing Committee shall assist the School Development Director with recruitment, retention of students and maintaining communications with the community at large while promoting the efforts of School and Catholic education as a whole.

Legislative Action Committee: The Legislative Action Committee works closely with the Catholic Education Arizona (formerly CTODP) staff and resources to effectively market the Arizona tax credit program. Committee works to find new and engaging ways to promote, educate and increase the School community's participation in the tax credit. Committee also keeps up to date with the diocesan Lobbyist on legislative matters pertaining to our Catholic schools and reports back to the Advisory Board as needed.

School Improvement Committee (SIT): The School Improvement Committee shall assist an appointed faculty member from the School in updating and maintaining a five-year plan to include enrollment, curriculum, staffing, facilities, finance and development. This committee will keep abreast of the Accreditation process and report to the Advisory Board regularly.

Catholic Identity Committee: The Catholic Identity Committee will review, recommend and implement a variety of programs that celebrate our Catholic faith while bringing students, faculty and community to a deeper relationship with Christ. The committee also works to nourish the spiritual dimension of the Advisory Board.

Technology Committee: The Technology Committee is tasked with collaborating, communicating and contributing to the use of technology to further advance the learning of students and employees. The committee will keep apprised of existing technology issues and provide guidance on the advantages and disadvantages and potential impact of emerging technologies while developing and implementing a School Technology Plan.

Finance Council Liaison: This individual shall represent the Advisory Board in financial matters relevant to the School while working in conjunction with the Parish Finance Council to formulate policies for long-range financial development and funding options, monitoring ongoing revenues and expenditures.
