Dear Saint John XXIII Community,

This has been a difficult week for our community. We have been working with the Diocese on the issues that have unfolded since their inception and have made them aware of all of our concerns. We are cooperating with the investigations and the Diocese has ensured me that more information will be provided to everyone once the investigations are complete.

Fr. Scott's resignation, and sadly some of the 'parking lot talk' and social media rumors that are circulating are taking their toll on the way many in our community feel in coming to our campus. No one should ever feel afraid to come to the school nor should there ever be an "uneasy" feeling about the place you leave your most precious gift each morning. I can certainly assure you that the safety of our campus and the safety of our children remains, as always, of primary importance. Many of you know that I am speaking both as the school principal and as a father, as my two children attend our school. I would not have my children here, nor would I continue to serve in my position if I did not believe that the environment is as safe as it could be.

I understand that the situation this past week is upsetting and that everyone would like "more information" from both the Diocese and the school. I also understand that it is difficult to be patient in these situations when we want answers. You are, as always, welcome to reach out to the Diocese during this time if you wish to express your concerns, or to stop by and chat with me. We will continue to have our teachers work with the kids to ensure that they feel safe and cared for during this period of change for them.

The events from this past week provide an opportunity to highlight the importance of our yearly safe-environment training. If we see something, or we are worried about the safety of a student, we MUST say something, no matter how menial it may seem at the time. As a faculty, we will continue to advocate for the students entrusted to our care regardless of the situation. We sincerely ask that each of our parents serve as the voice for your children so that they are heard if there is a concern. As Fr. Kline stated so aptly on Wednesday at Mass, "We love the kids and we are praying for them every day".

Thanks again for your understanding and your patience. "God is good, all the time! All the time, God is good. St. John XXIII, pray for us!"

SJXXIII school campus for 2 years! Previously, Jason has worked with seventh & eighth grade students from across the valley, helping them to prepare for the HSPT exam, interview, and essays for Catholic High Schools in Phoenix, with many of his former students gaining admission to and ultimately attending Brophy College Preparatory. Jason worked as the HSPT teacher at Brophy for the past three summers, helping more students to work towards their goals to being admitted to a Catholic High School.



#### Please join us as we remember Fr. Peter Rossa

Peter Anthony Rossa III was born on October 23, 1964 in Bath, Maine. As a priest in the Diocese of Phoenix for 14 years, Fr. Rossa served at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Scottsdale, St. Timothy in Mesa, and then the remainder of his years shepherding some 1,350 families at St. Bernadette in Scottsdale and at the parish school St. John XXIII. While at St. Bernadette, Fr. Rossa created the Adoration Chapel, oversaw the construction of a gym at St. John XXIII school and a beautiful new permanent church building.
